Any explanation about why some of the surplus out of the Decatur office seemed to be reassigned after libraries had already spoken for it?

We regret any confusion surrounding the surplus items from the Decatur office in late August and can share two scenarios that may have occurred. In the first, IHLS administration determined that chairs on the surplus list were needed for another IHLS office location. In the second, items were "held" for member libraries however that was not included in the surplus distribution plan.

Lessons learned: Once items are declared surplus they should remain surplus. All guidelines involving distribution of surplus items at Carterville were clearly stated in advance of the distribution.
